## Application

\* The Devlin-Schnable Memorial Scholarship was established by the Class of 1960 in memory of two classmates, Daniel J. Devlin and Jon E. Schnable. This award is for defraying the costs of summer field camp and is **based upon a student's need and exhibited scholarship**. Recipients and the distribution of funds is determined by the Earth, Environmental and Planetary Science Department Chair.

\* After returning from field camp the recipient is **required** to write a short essay about his or her experience. These essays are sent to the fellowship donors and representatives of the Class of 1960. If you are given an award you will receive more information on this requirement in your award letter.

**Funding:** The department receives up to 10 requests annually for this scholarship. Distribution of funds is dependent upon the income, the number of requests received, merit and financial need. As field camp is a capstone course, preference may be given to seniors and juniors.
